



JOB TITLE: Food & Recreation Associate

REPORTS TO: Department Supervisor, varies depending on assigned shift

PAY: \$19.82 per hour

CLASSIFICATION: Non-Exempt, Part-Time (15-32 hrs/week) or Full-Time 32-40 hrs/week)

JOB SUMMARY: The Food & Recreation Associate's role is our primary support in preparing food for our guests and providing housekeeping in between groups to ensure a clean environment. Other assignments may include facilitating recreational activities, grounds maintenance, or cashier in the snack shack. The most frequent shift will be prepping and cleaning after meals in the kitchen. All Food & Recreation Associate's participate in housekeeping duties between guest groups weekly. Depending on employee skills and schedules, Food & Recreation Associates may be assigned more often to one department.

VARIOUS SHIFTS & ASSIGNMENTS:

- Meal prep (breakfast, lunch, or dinner)
- Meal clean-up (breakfast, lunch, or dinner)
- Boats & waterfront (afternoon)
- Housekeeping (afternoon 1-2 days/week)
- Groundwork, landscaping
- Snack Shack (afternoon)

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Have Christ-like interactions with all guests and other staff
- Meal preparation duties include preparing food, cooking, serving food in buffet, organizing (duties may be affected by age)
- Meal clean up duties include cleaning up after meals, washing dishes, cleaning kitchen, wiping counters and tables, moving tables and chairs, organizing, sweeping, mopping, cleaning equipment
- Housekeeping duties include cleaning toilets, showers & sinks; vacuuming, taking out trash, wiping beds, disinfecting
- Waterfront/Boats duties include getting people in/out of boats safely, ensuring proper life jacket wearing, and assisting Lifeguards to enforce rules
- Snack Shack duties include cashier, running register, inventory, and stocking (must have additional inhouse training)
- Grounds work duties include raking, weeding, watering flowers, etc.
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Washington State Food Worker card, required (a link will be given upon hire)
- Must be able to stand for extended periods of time, required
- Must be able to lift/carry up to 50 pounds, required
- Must be okay working in a kitchen with common allergens, required
- Previous customer service experience, preferred
- This position includes shifts that take place outside in all weather conditions
